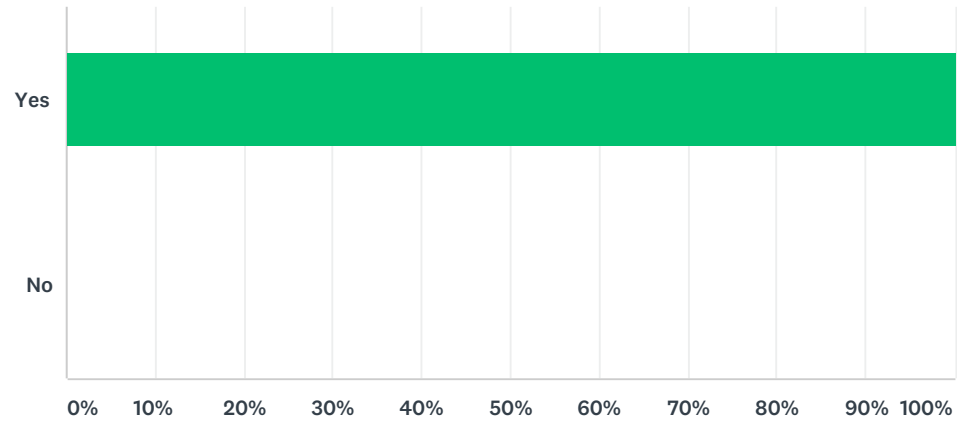
This was a voluntary exercise and not all the workforce completed the questionnaire so the results are only a snapshot and do not accurately reflect Chambers.

The data has not been broken down into further categories, e.g QCs, Junior members, staff etc. as such a format might lead to the identification of individuals.

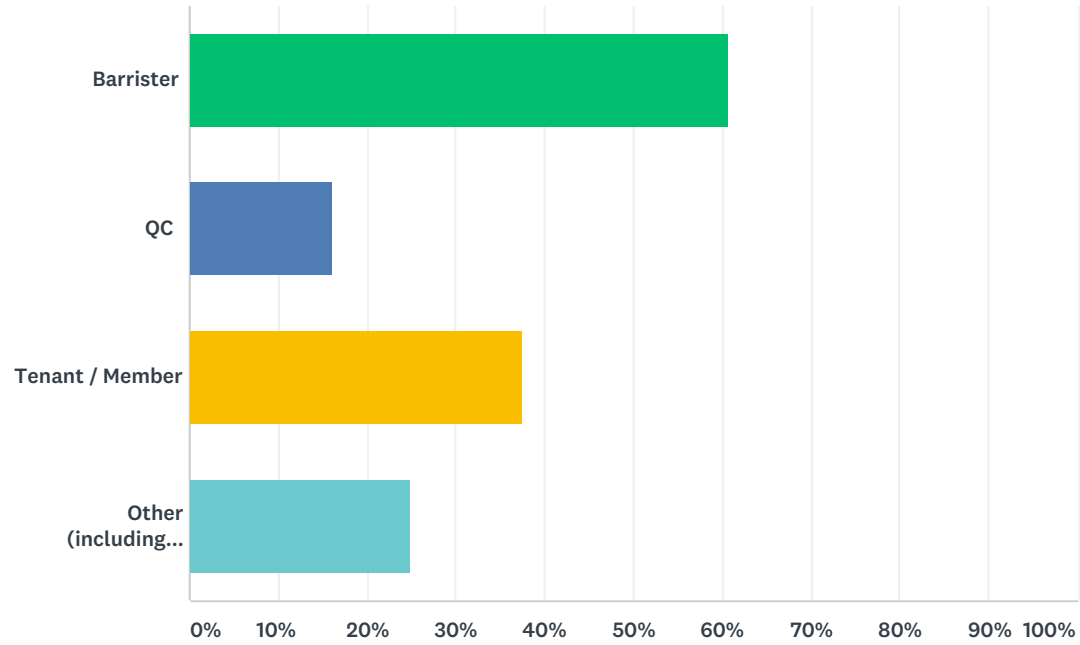

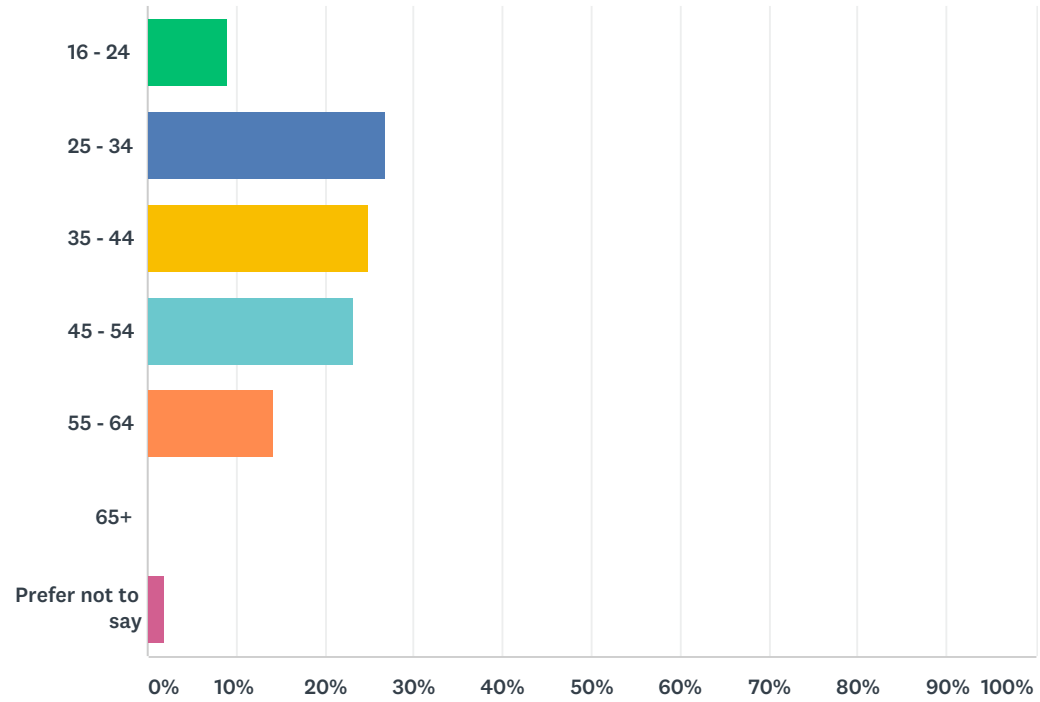
Percentage of Chambers Workforce

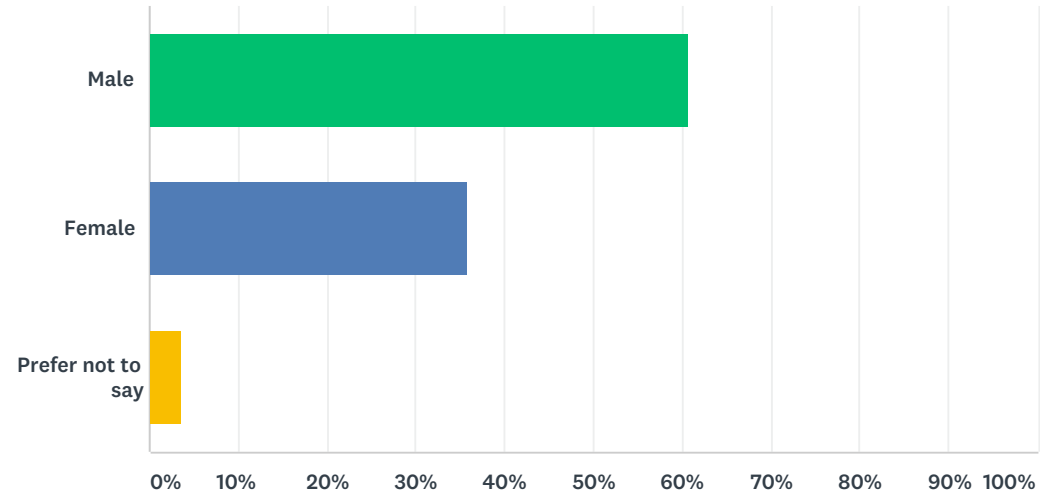
Age

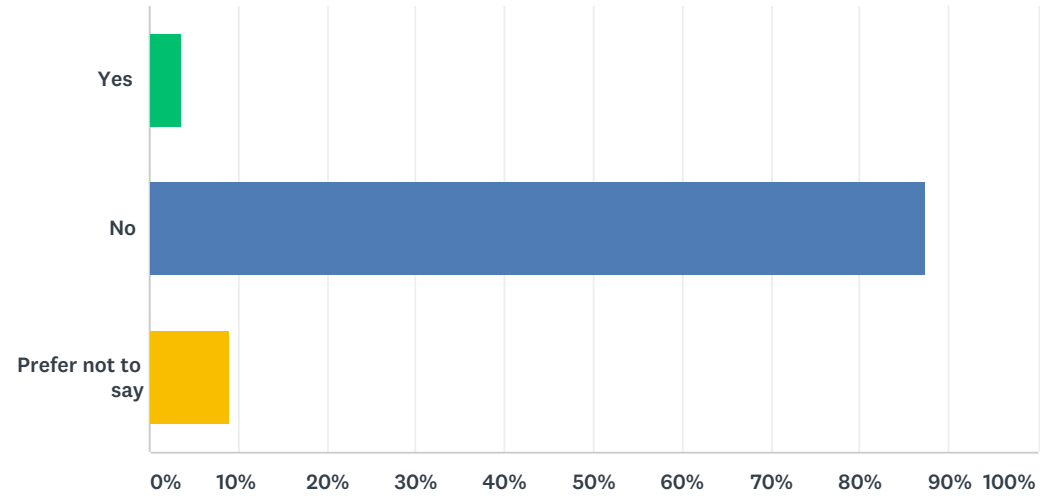
Gender

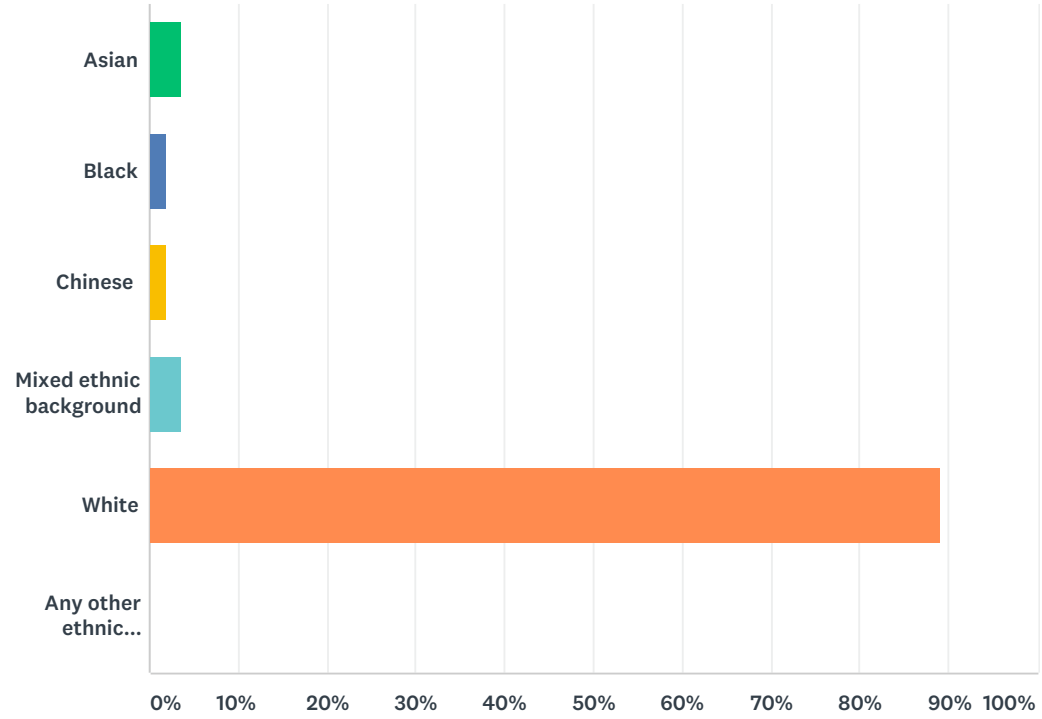
Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act?

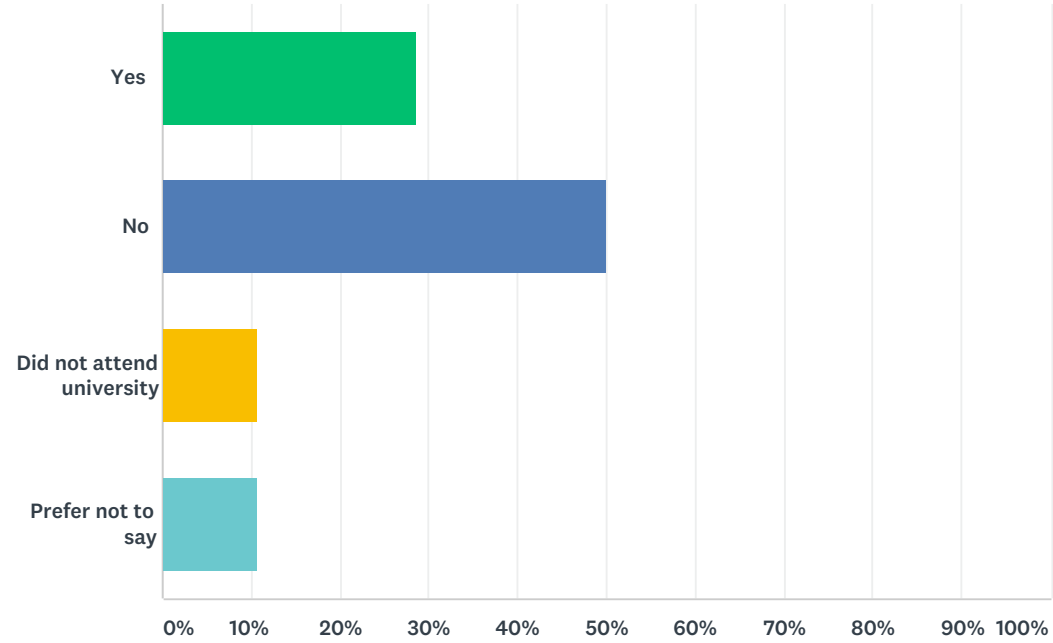
Ethnic Group

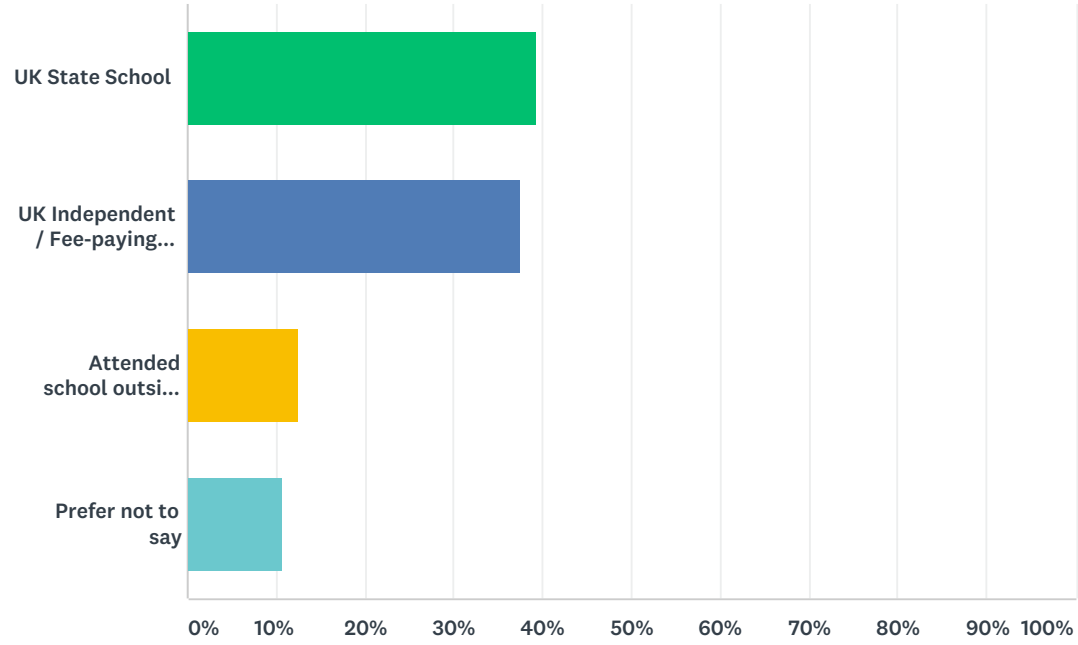
If you went to University, were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?
